Press Release

Sheriff Dahl reports at about 7:55 a.m. on June 9th, the Crow Wing County Sheriff's Office received a call to conduct a welfare check on a 54 year old Brainerd man that had not shown up for work for the last two days. About 5 minutes later the Sheriff's Office received a call of an abandoned boat floating on Nokay Lake, which is located about 10 miles east of Brainerd. The boat's registration came back to the same male individual as mentioned in the welfare check.

Crow Wing County Sheriff's Office Boat and Water Division searched the area with a Side Scan Sonar and other watercraft. They were assisted by the Minnesota DNR both on the water, and with aerial support.

On June 10th, the subject was located with side scan sonar. The Crow Wing County Dive Team was able to make a recovery at 9:41 a.m. The person recovered was identified as Raymond Achman age 54 from Brainerd, MN. The subject was transported to the Ramsey County Medical Examiner for autopsy.
