PRESS RELEASE

On 7-9-17 at approx. 1023 hours, The Crow Wing County Sheriff's Office received a call of a burglary in progress at a residence located on the 6100 block of Holiday Harbor Drive, in Garrison. It was learned that the homeowner, who was not home, was notified of an alarm at his residence. He then called a neighbor to go check the house. While the neighbor was checking the house, he discovered an unknown adult male walking around inside the house. He then called 911.

While officers were responding, another call came to the Sheriff's Office indicating that a male was attempting to steal a car from a neighboring house. Shortly after deputies' arrival, they located the male who was taken into custody. He was identified as 34 year old Justin D. Stevenson, of Kenyon, MN.

Through the investigation, it was determined that Stevenson had gained entry into the house through an unlocked garage window. While inside the house, Stevenson took items of clothing and food from the residence. Stevenson was unsuccessful in stealing the neighbors' car as he could not locate the keys.

Stevenson was booked into the Crow Wing County Jail for 2nd Degree burglary, Criminal Damage to Property and Misd. Theft.

The Crow Wing County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the MN State Patrol.
