### Crow Wing County Highway 66 Storm water Treatment Project to start after Labor Day

The Crow Wing Soil and Water Conservation District and Crow Wing County are notifying you that the Crow Wing County Road 66 Storm water Treatment Project has been awarded. The project location is approximately 1,000 feet north of the Big Trout Lake Public Landing. **Construction is planned to begin after Labor Day (Sept. 4, 2017) and the project substantially completed by October 13, 2017.** Prior to construction, the utility companies will be relocating their utilities in conflict with the proposed construction along County Road 66. County Road 66 will remain open to traffic in both directions but minor traffic delays may occur along the project due to shoulder closures. Access will be maintained to residents along County Road 66 during construction. We ask for your patience and understanding.
