A mobile version of the GIS Map is now available for Crow Wing County residents. The desktop version of this map helps residents quickly search property information throughout Crow Wing County. Users can easily find property owners and addresses, property values, legal descriptions, and view the 2016 aerial photo. Residents can also access their plat, recorded permits and tax statements.

This map has the same capabilities of the desktop version and now functions on phones and tablets. "Enjoy the convenience of this application while on the go." said GIS Coordinator Nate Rose. "The application was developed to be simple to navigate as well as accessible and applicable. It provides a wealth of GIS information that can be leveraged by businesses as well as the public.
