### CROW WING COUNTY LANDFILL WINTER HOURS

The Crow Wing County Landfill will begin winter hours starting the first week in November and will be open 8 am to 5 pm Monday through Friday. The landfill will be closed on Saturdays and Sundays from November 2018 through March 2019, and will re-open for summer hours starting in April 2019.

The landfill is open to the residents of Crow Wing County for recycling and disposal needs. Items accepted are household garbage, fiberglass boats, mattresses, furniture, mobile homes, and the following:

- Free recycling of lead-acid car/marine batteries – These can NOT be disposed of in the landfill
- Free compost of lawn and garden material (please separate brush and branches)
- A small fee for recycling of used oil filters and anti-freeze.
- Free oil recycling at the landfill and several drop-off locations within the County. Visit our webpage for drop-off locations: [www.crowwing.us](http://www.crowwing.us) and search “oil.”
- Demolition materials may be disposed in the demolition landfill for a fee
- Large appliances, electronics, tires with or without rims, scrap metals, glass, and plastic can be disposed at the site for a nominal fee for recycling.

Customers utilizing the landfill must stop at the Landfill Office and speak with the attendant to discuss the items to be disposed, pay any fees and receive directions to the proper drop-off locations. All loads coming to the County Landfill must be covered. Uncovered loads are subject to additional fees.

During the winter months (November through March), Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) will be open only for emergency situations such as residents who are moving, or an estate that must dispose of hazardous materials and cannot wait until the HHW program opens in May of 2019. This program is by appointment only during winter months. To schedule an appointment, contact the Land Services Department located at the Crow Wing County Landfill at (218) 839-0854.
