App to Assist in County Road Cleanup Coming in May

A roadside initiative project to connect residents to help clean up ditches along county roads will soon be unveiled. The project will bring together residents and local organizations to assist in roadside cleanup across Crow Wing County using an easy to use phone app. It will also include a fun twist that will bring a sense of ownership to county roads.

“The Highway Department has always been very proactive on keeping county roads and ditches clean. What’s great about this project is we took feedback from some really engaged residents who were already volunteering to clean up our roadways. We’ve been able to springboard off of that idea and create a user friendly app that will bring a sense of pride to our county roads.” said Highway Maintenance Supervisor Jory Danielson.

Residents are encouraged to participate in roadside cleanup. Many local groups take part in annual spring roadside cleanup on weekends in April and May.

Crow Wing County has more than 600 miles of county roads. There are 550 miles of county roads and an additional 63 miles in the First Assessment District (FAD) and Second Assessment District (SAD).
