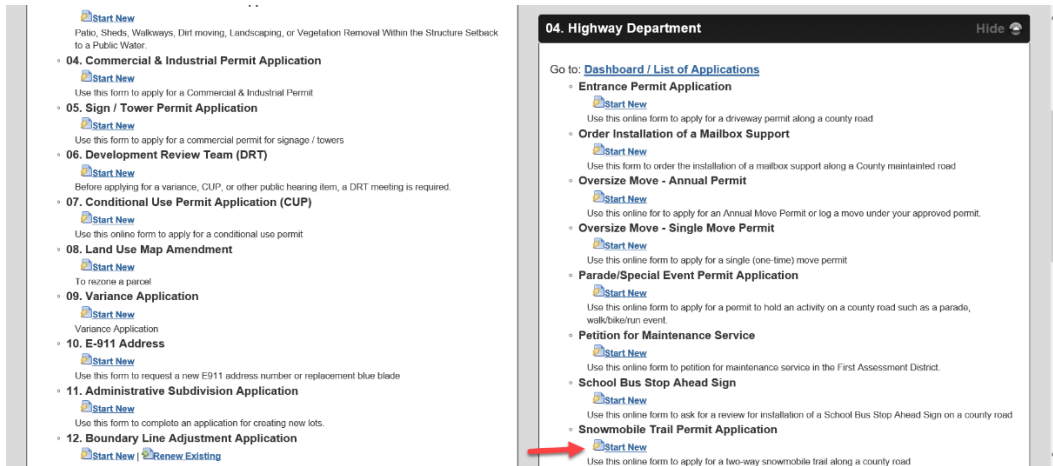

Snowmobile Trail Permit Application
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Please review the following information:

- 1) The Highway Department's primary concern is providing safe roadway conditions. this, at times, requires the use of the entire road right of way. it can be expected that snow removal operations will effect regularly groomed snow mobile trails. the Highway Department shall not be responsible for damage or other effects of snow deposited on trails from roadway snow plowing operations.
- 2) Trail groomers shall not deposit snow on or near bridges or any roadway shoulder. If snowmobile use or grooming operations create a public nuisance or safety hazards, the County Engineer may void or suspend this authorization.
- 3) The removal of vegetation or obstacles from snowmobile trails not directly impacting the safety of the roadway user shall be the responsibility of the trail sponsor. Permission from adjacent landowners shall be received by the trail sponsor prior to conducting any vegetation removal.
- 4) Damage to private or public property, such as culverts, signs and approaches, caused by snowmobile use or groomer operations shall be the responsibility of the trail sponsor. All damage shall be promptly reported to the County Engineer.
- 5) Additional County Highway Department stipulations may be made in the Notes section of the permit.
